

SPAY DAY USA

Dogwood Animal Shelter does everything within our means to get dogs and cats "fixed"! It's part of our mission, it makes for healthier, happier pets, and it reduces suffering.

For the past two years, Dogwood Animal Shelter has participated in SPAY DAY USA, an annual campaign to inspire people to save



animals' lives by spaying and neutering pets and feral cats. Spay Day is held on the last Tuesday of February and, at Dogwood, our goal is to spay and neuter up to 50 stray and feral cats in our low cost clinic on that day. Our involvement in this campaign has resulted in the prevention of thousands of unwanted litters at the Lake of the Ozarks and surrounding areas.

For the last two years, prior to the actual Spay Day, we've held a SPAY-ghetti Dinner to raise funds for our Spay/Neuter Assistance Fund. This fund helps folks who could not otherwise afford to spay or neuter the strays that show up at their doorsteps. Many times, even \$10 in assistance can make the difference between an animal getting fixed or not!

This year, the SPAY-ghetti Dinner will be held at Li'l Rizzo's in Osage Beach on Tuesday, Feb. 8th from 5-8pm. (Bad weather date is Feb. 15.) Last year's SPAY-ghetti Dinner proceeds helped about 100 needy pets get "fixed"!

We sure appreciate Li'l Rizzo's help with this important fundraiser!


